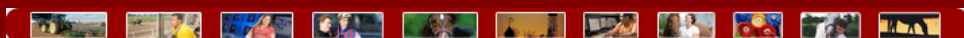
HOOFPRIENTS TRIBUTE Trinket - June 1986 - April 2016
