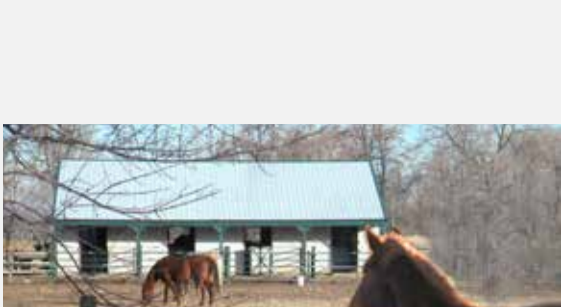

1. General Facility

The larger the facility + new horses/people + large/changing horse groups = the larger the biosecurity risk

2. Housing Materials

The more porous the floors/walls = the bigger the biosecurity risk

3. Horse Movement

Travelling and commingling = increased biosecurity risk

4. New Horses

New and visiting horses = increased biosecurity risk



New horse arriving at farm

5. Vaccination/Deworming

Sharing needles/syringes between horses = increased biosecurity risk

6. People Movement

The higher the people traffic = the higher the biosecurity risk



Multiple trailers at a horse event



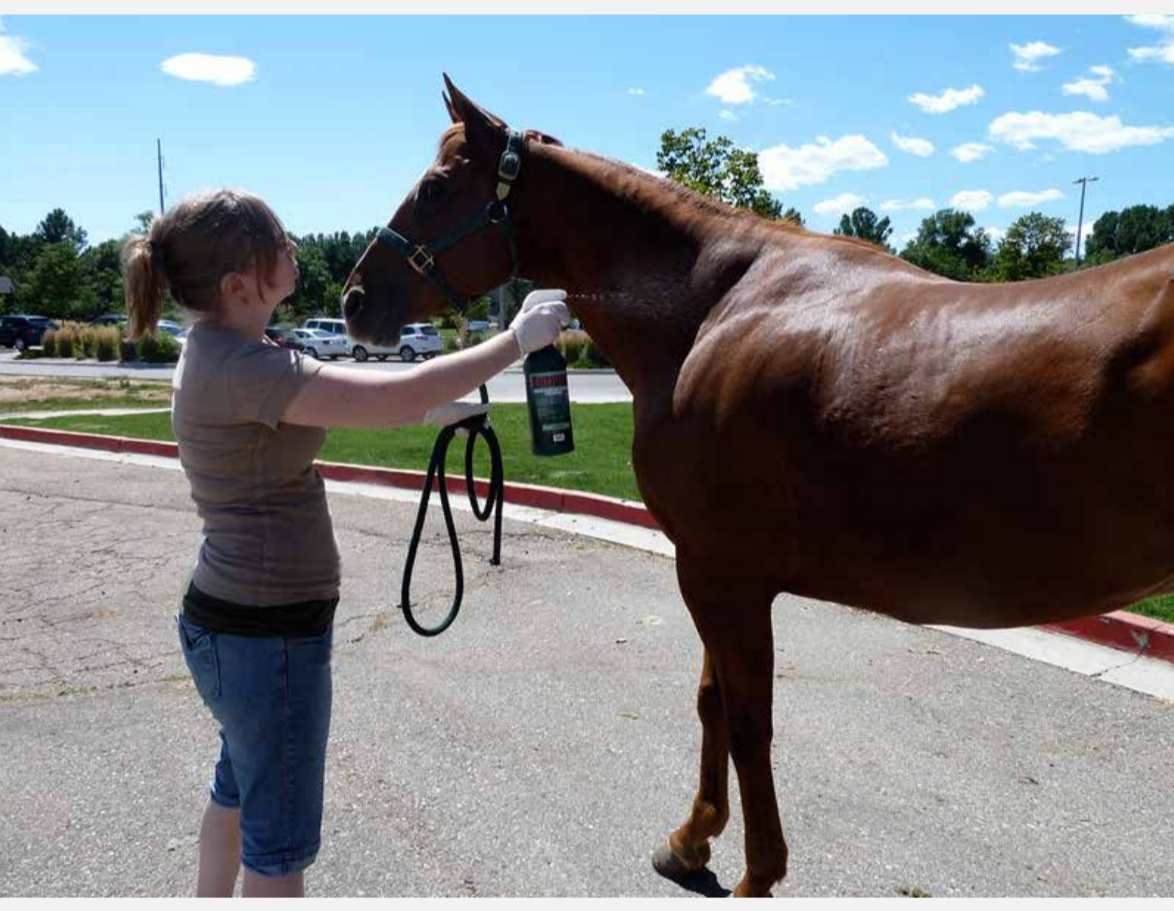
Open horse facility entry sign



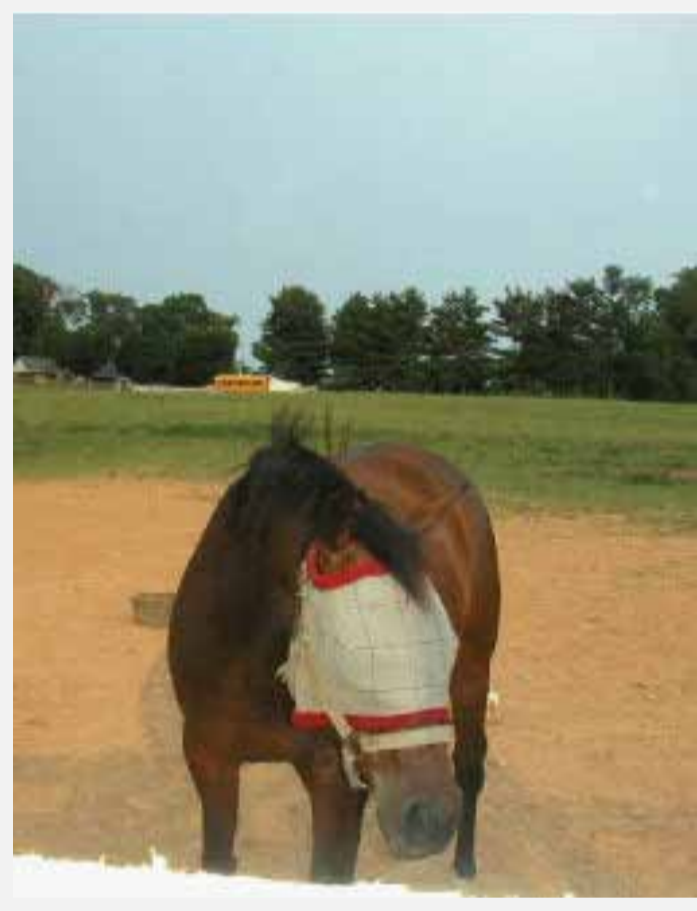
Closed horse facility entry sign

7. Pest Control

Insect control = reduced biosecurity risk



Owner administering fly spray

8. Infection Control

Sanitation = reduced biosecurity risk



Sink available for hand washing on horse facility



Soaps and alcohol cleanser available for hand washing

9. Sick Horses

Identifying sick horses = reduced biosecurity risk



Horse exhibiting nasal purulence (snotty nose)



Taking rectal temperature of a horse to monitor for signs of disease

10. Isolation

Isolation of sick horses = reduced biosecurity risk



Isolation facility located away from main resident horse barn
